Late December, Bobby and I got some very sad news. Our dear friend, Jim Hitt passed away. I featured him in a very interesting Highway Stories in issue 5. He stayed with us for a week last year and we did some traveling with him as well on one of our trips south. Here is some of that interview that didn't make the article.



"Life did provide some tough lessons though. At age 14, I lost my left arm in an unfortunate encounter with a hay baler. There wasn't time or inclination for a pity party. I was a teen in the prime of life and there was too much living to be done to waste time feeling sorry for myself. As soon as I got my

hook and realized I could pull the clutch lever on the dirt bike, I was completely unencumbered and mobile with no restrictions on where I could go. My mother inspired a love of reading, with her daily Bible readings of which I was highly ambivalent at the time. Yet it was that daily reading that prompted my love of learning. My father's love of adventure with annual trips out west for elk hunts, and to Canada fishing with float plane rides over Lake of the Woods and driving adventures circling the great lakes, and the necessity of invention to facilitate farm life, was a better prep school than any lvy league institution could have ever imparted. Nothing seemed impossible. Life was an incredible adventure wrapped in colorful paper and gaudy bows, just wanting to be unwrapped and experienced." When I asked him what he thought of the area and if he planned on coming back, he had this to say, "Love it! People are friendly. Anywhere Little Bobby is, the music is incredible, inspiring and soul shattering. Will I return? Abso-forkin-lutely. Does a priest attend Mass? I worship at the House of Blues with the same reverence. It is an honor to participate with Little Bobby leading the services. It is an even greater honor to call him a friend." Jim Hitt was an amazing person, an awesome musician and an inspiring writer. He will be greatly missed.


Brouse on harp. The next night, Project: Constellation graced our stage once again and played more amazing originals. The

<u> Vet's Corner </u>

In this issue, I'm not featuring a vet, but someone who's spent decades supporting and funding them. Her name is Angela and you may already know her as "The Rose Girl. Her first fundraiser was for soldiers in Irag on July 4th 2003. She raised money for phone cards so soldiers could keep in touch with their families at home. That was 2 weeks before she bought the company. She started raising money for the honor flight in 2005 when she sponsored her first Veteran. She also supports many other causes one of which being the YMCA. She sponsors fifty children each year for the partner of youth program. She somehow finds the time to do all this while also working full-time at American Woods in Grand Forks and selling flowers each Friday and Saturday night. I asked her how and why she started all this. When she was in college, a professor learned that she was not able to make a car payment and took it upon herself to go to her church and take up a collection for Angela. The professor made \$333. Angela told her she couldn't take the money because she couldn't repay it. The professor said, "Yes, you can pay it forward. When you get an opportunity to help somebody else, that's what you do. You pay it forward." The veterans have been her main fundraising organizations since 2017 and she has sent 22 veterans on the honor flight. She also has joined forces with Mikey who does a trivia night donating all proceeds to the Honor Flight. Angela says, "You have to be the change you want to see in the world." I challenge anyone to try representing that statement better than her! Way to go, Angela! You're so appreciated for supporting our veterans!
